Overall, despite some recent growth, the grass remains at a suitable height. <br> 3. The children's playground was visually inspected. A parent asked if a rubber mat can be installed at the base of the metal slide (in the absence of sufficient bark mulch) to prevent children landing on hard ground (Photo 1). Likewise, comments have been made about the lack of bark mulch. <br> 4. The fitness/gym equipment was found in working order (please see outstanding items listed below). <br> 5. Dog poo bag dispensers were replenished. <br> 6. The memorial bench next to the children's playground needs to be refastened to the ground (Photo 2). All other outdoor furniture was seen in good order. <br> 7. Tree branches above the village shop have been lopped (Photo 3). <br> 8. The wooded area situated between the playground and former police house is overgrown with numerous trees in poor condition (Photos 4,5 and 6 ). A lot of deadwood is visible. Some thinning out of the woodland would be beneficial, improving appearance, deter rubbish accumulation, and anti-social activity. <br> Outstanding items: <br> Gym <br> The Twist and Step Gym station and cycling machine are missing important user information labels. <br> Playground <br> - Replacement of decayed tree trunk step (crooked playhouse). <br> - A missing wooden bracket needs reinstating on the spiral shaped slide. <br> - Protective plastic cap covering a metal bolt is missing on the Multi Play equipment. <br> - Grip surface is worn on the Multi Play platforms and needs replacing. <br> General <br> - An emergency access sign is missing on the gate by the village shop. <br> - Net stanchions are missing on a football goalframe. <br> - Charred debris from the firework display awaits disposal. |
